### **Updates from New York Air Brake, CXT, Sam Schwartz Engineering, OnTrackAmerica and Tartaglia Railroad Services**

- New York Air Brake Corp. won a contract to design and build five customized simulators for MPRI, a division of L3 Communications. The simulators will be sold to the Egyptian National Railways, which is trying to modernize its freight- and passenger-rail services. To be installed at a new facility in Wardan, Egypt, the simulators will be used to train new and experienced rail personnel to operate the Canadian, Henschel, Adtranz, GE and EMD locomotives in the railway's motive-power fleet.
